Dear Greater Miami Expressway Agency Stakeholders,

As you may be aware, during the 2023 Regular Legislative Session, the Florida Legislature clarified the legal status, ownership, and control of the roads that constitute the expressway system in Miami-Dade County and portions of northeast Monroe County. (*348.03031(1), Fla. Stat.*). Furthermore, the Legislature clarified the authority of the Greater Miami Expressway (GMX) Agency and dissolved the Miami-Dade Expressway Authority. (*Chapter 2019-169, Laws of Florida; 348.03031(4), Fla. Stat., and 2019-169, Laws of Florida*)

The goal of the GMX board is to ensure a compassionate, transparent, and timely transition. Existing contracts, financial obligations, and bond payments will remain in place and be unaffected. Employees will continue to receive salaries and wages from GMX without interruption. GMX wants to assure the traveling public of South Florida that their services will not be interrupted.

The GMX board members and staff are excited and prepared to work with you during this transition. The GMX governing board will meet on Wednesday, July 5 to outline the framework for this transition.
