

YOUR FREQUENT DRIVER REFUND CHECK IS ON THE WAY!

MDX mailed more than 52,000 toll refund checks this week, with the average qualifying customer receiving at least \$110. MDX's frequent customers should expect to receive their check by December 20th.

The Miami-Dade County Expressway Authority's Board of Directors approved a rebate of 30 percent of the tolls consumed by the frequent drivers and daily commuters on the MDX expressways in their August meeting.

You will be able to log into your MDX Frequent Driver Rewards Program account **this weekend** to view information on past refunds and if you will be receiving one this year. You must log in at www.mdxway.com/frequentdriver/login.

Please note: ***This is not a SunPass® program so logging into your SunPass® account will not provide this this information.***

Only tolls collected on the five local MDX expressways: the Gratigny Parkway (924), the Airport Expressway (112), the Dolphin Expressway (836), the Don Shula Expressway (874), and the Snapper Creek Expressway (878) are eligible for the rebate. Tolls collected by the State of Florida's Department of Transportation (FDOT) on the Florida Turnpike, the I-95 Express Lanes and the new Palmetto Express Lanes are not eligible.

The effective toll rate for customers receiving a refund check this year after a 30 percent discount is as follows:

Gratigny Expressway (924)

Effective toll rates reduced from 47 cents to 33 cents per mainline toll gantry. For those driving the entire length from reduced from 94 cents to 66 cents total.

Airport Expressway (112)

Effective tolls reduced from 33 cents to 23 cents per mainline toll gantry. For those driving the entire length from 66 cents to 46 cents total.

Dolphin Expressway (836)

Effective tolls reduced from 66 cents to 46 cents per mainline toll gantry. For those driving the entire length from 137th Avenue to I-95 from \$2.26 to \$1.58 total.

Don Shula Expressway (874)

Effective tolls reduced from 47 cents to 33 cents and from 23 cents to 16 cents per toll gantry respectively. For those driving the entire length from 93 cents to 65 cents total.

Snapper Creek Expy. (878)

Effective tolls reduced from 23 cents to 16 cents per toll gantry. For those driving the entire length from 46 cents to 32 cents total.
