Felix M. Lasarte Reappointed to MDX Board of Directors

MIAMI, Fla., August 8, 2012 – Felix M. Lasarte has been reappointed by the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners to the Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) board of directors for a term of four years.

Mr. Lasarte is the founder of The Lasarte Law Firm, which specializes in real estate law, with a concentration on land use and zoning. Of the 12 volunteers, Florida's Governor appoints five of them and the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners appoints the remaining seven members.

The Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) is a public entity and agency of the state, created in 1994 by the Board of County Commissioners of Miami-Dade County. MDX's Governing Board is comprised of 13 volunteer members appointed either by the Board of County Commissioners and the Governor of the State of Florida. MDX operates and maintains five expressways: SR 112/Airport Expressway, SR 836/Dolphin Expressway, SR 874/Don Shula Expressway, SR 878/Snapper Creek Expressway, and SR 924/Gratigny Parkway. MDX is funded almost entirely by toll revenue and is dedicated to moving Miami-Dade County forward making your commute
