Position Summary

The SQL Server DBA / Developer will be responsible for the implementation, configuration, maintenance, and performance of critical SQL Server RDBMS systems, to ensure the availability and consistent performance of our corporate data warehouse and business intelligence solution. The candidate will be responsible on developing and managing the GMX internet website and intranet site. This is a “hands-on” position requiring solid technical skills, as well as excellent interpersonal and communication skills.

The candidate will be responsible for the development and sustainment of the SQL Server Data Warehouse and business intelligence solution, ensuring its operational readiness (security, health and performance), executing data loads, and performing data modeling in support of the business. The data warehouse supports multiple program management tools.

Essential Duties

- Recommends, evaluates, and implements the appropriate information technology solutions in accordance to industry standards and best practices.
- Coordinate with Agency’s departments to investigate, review needs, and requirements to make recommendations.
- Assists GMX Public Communications supporting campaign initiatives, project and information dissemination to the public through the GMX website.
- Create and maintain documentation and operational procedures on systems and communication networks.
- Work with staff and outside consultants to make the GMX systems interoperable to facilitate the sharing of information.
- Technical knowledge in integration, interface creation and development.
- System design, architecture and integration techniques.
- Implement and maintain data warehouses
- Manage SQL Server databases through multiple product lifecycle environments, from development to mission-critical production systems
- Apply data modeling techniques to ensure development and implementation support efforts meet integration and performance expectations
- Design, develop and maintain business intelligence reports and dashboards
- Configure and maintain database servers and processes, including monitoring of system health and performance, to ensure high levels of performance, availability, and security
- Independently analyze, solve, and correct issues in real time, providing problem resolution end-to-end
- Refine and automate regular processes, track issues, and document changes
- Assist developers with complex query tuning and schema refinement
- Provide 24x7 support for critical production systems

- Windows Operation Systems and database connectivity.

- Experience with backups, restores and recovery models
- Knowledge of High Availability (HA) and Disaster Recovery (DR) options for SQL Server (optional)
- Experience working with Windows server, including Active Directory
- Excellent written and verbal communication
- Flexible, team player, “get-it-done” personality
- Ability to organize and plan work independently
- Ability to work in a rapidly changing environment
- Ability to multi-task and context-switch effectively between different activities and teams
- Knowledge of project management.
