## **Over 82,800 SunPass Accounts Registered for MDX Cash Back Toll Dividend Program**

*Authority Plans to Return Cash Rebates to MDX Customers*

**MIAMI** – MDX announced today that over 82,800 SunPass accounts have been enrolled in the MDX Cash Back Toll Dividend Program (CBTD). This initiative, believed to be the first of its kind in the United States, is the agency’s free customer loyalty program.

“We are thrilled that our cash rebate program has connected with our commuters,” said MDX Executive Director Javier Rodriguez, P.E. “Simply by registering for the CBTD during our open enrollment period, which ended on August 31, members will see their overall toll costs lowered if they meet the requirements of the program.”

The 2015 dividend distribution will be announced at the agency’s next board meeting scheduled for September 29, 2015 at 4 p.m. in the MDX Headquarters Boardroom, 3790 NW 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Miami, Florida 33142.

The MDX Board of Directors will declare a distribution of dividends to members of the CBTD program each fiscal year, which occurs from July 1 through June 30, after the agency has closed its financial books. This distribution of dividends is declared after MDX meets its financial obligations, including making its annual principal and interest payments, meeting its senior debt coverage ratio and covering its operation and maintenance costs. The agency will begin issuing rebate checks to MDX customers in December.
